

He said that he has not ingested illegal drugs, smoked marijuana nor consumed alcohol within the twenty-four hours of taking this polygraph examination. It should be noted that Mr. BANDY does not consume alcohol.

When asked about his behavior that caused his arrest and prosecution, Mr. BANDY said on November 11, 2004, the City of Phoenix Police and the FBI visited his parents home and executed a search and scizure warrant for the family computer. According to Mr. BANDY, the authorities allegeded that he downloaded child pornography. Mr. BANDY adamantly denies ever uploading any form of child pornography. He father stated that he does not know how to upload images into the computer. He said that the family computer is used by his sister Kiatic BANDY, age fourteen, his mother Jeanne BANDY, age forty-nine and his father Greg BANDY, age forty-nine. He further stated that when his family leaves on vacation his parents allow the house sitter to use the family computer. Mr. BANDY told me that he does not have a credit card and that his parents have never allowed him to use their credit card to subscribe to adult pornography. Mr. BANDY said that the web site *Yahoo Groups* is a free service. He stated that his screen name is *JOEBEAN1988HOOPDU*. He further stated that the times that it has been allegeded that he has viewed pornography he was either asleep (school night) or having dinner with his family. Mr. BANDY adamantly denies uploading, downloading or viewing child pornography.

No additional statements or admissions were forthcoming during the pre-test interview.

Relevant Questions Reviewed and Asked on Polygraph Examination:

Question R#1: Have you ever viewed child pornography on the Internet?

Answer: NO

Question R#2: Have you ever logged on the Internet to view child pornography?

Answer: NO

Question R#3: Have you ever intentionally down loaded child pornography?

Answer: NO

Data from Mr. BANDY'S physiological responses were monitored during multiple presentations of the above questions and subjected to numerical scoring. The responses were monitored by a Lafayette Electronic Polygraph Instrument. These physiological responses included: relative blood pressure, skin conductance and both thoracic and abdominal respiration.

TEST RESULTS: Based on analysis of the polygraph charts using nationally standardized scoring methods, Mr. BANDY physiological responses, to the relevant questions are consistent with the usual indications of non deceptive, resulting in a final result of *No Deception*.

PROFESSIONAL OPINION: Therefore, it is this examiner's opinion that Mr. BANDY *was being truthful* when he answered the above listed relevant questions.

The American Polygraph Association (APA) mandates clear and significantly high, truthful or deceptive scores before any definitive conclusions can be rendered. These guidelines were developed to prevent erroneous conclusions, so that conclusive results would illustrate exceptionally high validity and reliability. Questions other than those listed were used on the test to evaluate responses, but no decisions as to truth or deception is made on those questions.

He provided no further statements or admissions at this time.
